Hello Columbia Family,
We're excited for school to start on Monday! It'll be fun to have all the students back.

1. As a reminder, this Monday, August 23, is the first day of school for students in grades 1-6. School begins at 8:45 A.M. and on this first day, we will all meet on the playground near the 4Square courts. The teachers will be holding up a sign with their names on it. Please find and stand by your teacher. We will recite The Pledge of Allegiance together and then teachers will walk with their students to their classroom. School will normally be dismissed at $3: 25$, but ON THE FIRST DAY AND ON EVERY FRIDAY, STUDENTS WILL BE DISMISSED AT 1:25.
