- 1. Message from Principal Denhalter: So many great things are happening at the school. Our Veterans Day assembly was touching. Other seasonal activities are happening. Our school choir will be singing the National Anthem in the Vivint Smart Home Arena next week. Before we know it, Christmas Break will be upon us. I am grateful for everyone who comes together to make Columbia Elementary such an excellent school.
- 2. Attendance Hotline Information: If your child needs to be absent from school, please report it ahead of time by leaving a message on our attendance hotline, 801-402-3356. This hotline is available 24-7.
- 3. Drop-Off/Pick-Up Safety Procedures: We are planning on sharing a bit more creatively again in January, but for now I need to share a few reminders. Please yield to students (pedestrians) when they are in the crosswalks. Please wait for crosswalks to be completely clear before driving through them. Please use the southwest parking lot for student pick-up and drop-off. Please only pick-up/drop-off students in the long straight section, avoiding the curved areas at the entrance and exit (these areas congests traffic flow). If you need to wait for your child, please park in a stall so you're not idling and blocking traffic. If you park in a stall, please walk children to and from your car, preferably using crosswalks. Please avoid using the north parking lot.
- **4. Paper Recycling:** Did you know that we have a paper recycling dumpster in the southeast parking lot? You are welcome to recycle paper here. Please deposit papers outside of school hours to avoid traffic congestion. This dumpster is clearly marked and is only for paper and cardboard. Please do not use it for plastic or trash. Recycling paper helps the school earns money per pound.

- 5. Student Council -Christmas Tree Service Project: Have you seen the Christmas tree in the school's office? Our student council is organizing a Christmas Tree service project and are looking for donations of gloves, mittens, beanies, scarves, socks and underwear for children and adults. These donations will be given to children (and some older kids and parents) who reside locally. If you would like to donate, come hang your items on the branches of the tree, or send them to the school office and we'll hang them for you.
- **6. Inclement Weather Guidelines:** Please send your children to school with clothing that is suitable for the weather conditions. Please write your child's name on coats, gloves, etc. so when they are lost, we can return them when found. We closely monitor weather and air quality. Generally, we keep the children indoors when weather is rainy or below 20 degrees.
- 7. School Lockout Drill: We will conduct a lockout drill at Columbia Elementary tomorrow morning (5 December 2018). A lockout means all doors are locked and no one is let in or out of the building while in lockout. School continues as normal. A lockout is called when there is a threat or hazard outside the school building. Typically, law enforcement or another emergency agency asks the school to go into a lockout. In the event of an actual lockout, parents will be informed once the school has full and accurate information. We appreciate your cooperation as we practice lockout procedures with your child. We value your children's safety and want to be prepared in the event of an actual threat.
- **8.** Attendance Summary: We're projecting great improvement with absences and tardies so far this year. Please keep making prompt school attendance a priority.
